Travel time and/or expenses will not be reimbursed separately;" however, the fee form requests a Fixed Fee rather than an hourly-based fee for both the Required Services and the Optional Services. Please confirm that the project will be Fixed Fee based rather than hourly-based?	The project will be Fixed Fee but please note that under the Terms and Conditions, the Government of Canada has the right to audit invoices for payment. This audit may include a breakdown of actual hours spent on each deliverable.
2. Appendix C - Price Proposal Form breaks up each of the phases into deliverables, requesting a price per deliverable and in some instances duplicating fees (for example there is a line item for RS4 as a whole, and then 4 sub items for the 4 different submissions). It is much more typical for Proponents to provide a fixed fee by overall phase — please confirm that a Fixed Fee by overall phase should be provided and if so, provide an updated Price Proposal Form?
