APPENDIX A - DEO SECURITY CLAUSES

Security Clauses #1 – No Security Requirement, <u>escort required at DFO site(s)</u>, except for public zones.

 permission of the Contracting Authority (i.e. a new SRCL must be submitted and processed following
 the same procedure as for the initial contract).
