1. Advance Contract Award Notice (ACAN)

An ACAN is a public notice indicating to the supplier community that a department or agency intends to award a contract for goods, services or construction to a pre-identified supplier, thereby allowing other suppliers to signal their interest in bidding, by submitting a statement of capabilities. If no supplier submits a statement of capabilities that meets the requirements set out in the ACAN, on or before the closing date stated in the ACAN, the contracting officer may then proceed with the award to the pre-identified supplier.

2. Definition of the requirement

The National Research Council (NRC) of Canada, Canadian Photonics Fabrication Centre, in Ottawa, ON has a requirement for modification assembly to upgrade two existing Edward Vacuum Inc ATLAS Abatement systems (Serial #106282464, 166010658) to support expansion of fabrication activities and to align with NRC's environmental stewardship objectives.

The required product is manufactured by Edwards Vacuum Inc., the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) and the required part is, NRG897000. The part must be fully combatable with the existing ATLAS Abatement System while allowing scrubbers to operate at NRC's enhanced burn modulation capabilities.

3. Criteria for assessment of the Statement of Capabilities (Minimum Essential Requirements)

Any interested supplier must demonstrate by way of a statement of capabilities that its product/equipment/system (as appropriate) meets the following requirements:

Provide a quantity of two OEM Part # NRG897000 Atlas Etch to KRS/ETCH upgrades.

Each NRG897000 upgrade assembly must include the following and be approved by the OEM for use in the existing ATLAS abatement systems. Additionally, the OEM must be able to continue to provide support for the entire assembly, tool, and unit as a whole in the future to performance specification with the inclusion of a third-party part.

- i. Head Assy/Upgrade Parts (Quadrants, Actuators, purges lines, etc. to support the Kronis/Etch upgrade),
- ii. New Fuel block with inject lines,
- iii. New O2 block and O2 lines.
- iv. associated software patch to control supplied fuel block valves when valves for Etch/Kronis actuate.
