Question 1: We have a chair that meets all the other requirements except the headrest. Can you please make the headrest optional?	No, the chairs needs to have a headrest as requested in the RFB

Question 4 We respectfully object to the specification for 2" of horizontal inward adjustment when the seat width has not been defined. What inside clearance is the client trying to obtain since the only requirement under the SA is a minimum seat width? There is no way of quantifying that the inward adjustment would meet an operational need when you can by example have 5 different qualifying chairs with 5 different seat widths, so by this example, the required 2" inward adjustment will have 5 different inside arm clearances (Please refer to BIFMA G1-2013, pg. 26 sec. 7.1.3 and Z412-17(2023) sec. A.3.25.3). As there is no operational requirement that can justify this specification this requirement should be removed from the RFB or the CA should respectfully accept the supplier's standard inward adjustment range. Question 5 We respectfully object to the specification for a 360-degree swivel arm. Can the CA please explain what support the client would be looking for beyond possibly a 30-degree inward and outward rotation that already exceeds the minimum CGSB standard of the SA? What support is required at 180 degrees, or at 275 degrees that warrants the arm to swivel around in a full circle that in practice will just return to the same position it started?
