4.4.1 Minimum Point Rating

1. To be declared responsive, a bid must:
 - a. comply with all the requirements of the bid solicitation; and
 - b. meet all mandatory technical evaluation criteria; and
 - c. obtain the required minimum of 35 points overall for the technical evaluation criteria which are subject to point rating. The rating is performed on a scale of 60 points

2. Bids not meeting (a) or (b) or (c) will be declared non-responsive. The responsive bid with the lowest evaluated price will be recommended for award of a contract.
