1	We would like to request clarification for the following: Section 3.2.4 Senior Personnel Expertise and Experience lists 19 different categories of Senior Personnel for which Parks Canada has requested a resume. Can the same Senior Personnel be presented in more than one category, for example can we present the same person for Senior Environmental Scientist - specialized in Biology and Senor Environmental Scientist - specialized in Impact Assessment or do all 19 resources need to be unique?	The same resource can be identified, but the onus is on the proponent to ensure all requirements are satisfied. If this person is dedicated to one or more senior personnel, a backup will be required in case there is conflict where the person cannot satisfy both requirements due to scheduling/resource constraints.
2.a	We have the following questions regarding Solicitation No. 5P468-24-0002/A a) Is there a rough breakdown percentage of project categories type during this Standing Offer? For example, how much is percentage would it be Phase I ESA, Phase II/III ESAs, HHERA, EIA, and/or Remedial options reviews?	Not at this time.
