Answer 1:

Question 2:

Please advise if question #3 submitted on April 25th will be formally responded to through published Q&A. Question #3 submitted April 25th:

We note that the standard IM/IT limitation of liability (N0000C) was not included in the RFP. In accordance with Part C – Resulting Model Contract Clauses – of Supply Arrangement for TBIPS, we request that section 21 of Part C be added to the resulting contract. Section 21 has been added below for ease of reference. Please note that should this clause not be accepted and added to the resulting contract clauses, our firm will not be able to submit a proposal for the subject solicitation.

Answer 2:

To the extent possible, the Articles in the Resulting Model Contract clauses are written as they will appear in any future contracts resulting from the TBIPS Supply Arrangement, however, individual resulting contract clauses may be modified to suit individual Client requirements. CSA decided not to add the clause IM/IT limitation of liability (N0000C) to this RFP, considering it's end date of bid submission.
