

Questions for W0152-24-AA008 - SA RFP for Office Seating - Rotary Chair

Q1 - Do the chairs in tables A1 & A2 need to be the same model?

Q2 - Section B: Back rest height: Is there a required minimum back height and does the back height need to be adjustable to accommodate a higher percentage of users?

Q3 - Section C: Lumbar support: Does the lumbar support need to be depth adjustable independent of the back angle adjustment?

Q4 - Section D Armrests:: Do the arm pads need to move in laterally at least 2 " ea while in the parallel position independent of the arm width adjustment?

Q5 - Weight Capacity: will the Client accept a chair with a 350lb weigh capacity as long as the seat pan is designed for a larger user (wider and longer)

---

A1 – Yes they need to be the same model if possible.

A2 – Backrest must be between 18in and 26 in. and adjustable.

A3 – Yes, Lumbar support is to be fully adjustable.

A4 – Yes, arm pad must be able to move in all directions.

A5 – Yes, 350lbs rated chair falls within the requirement.
