This amendment is raised to:

A. Answer questions from bidders

A. Questions and Answers

- **Q42.** The response to Question 32 in Amendment 2 reads, "Senior Professionals and Intermediate Professionals in all disciplines must be registered as a P.Eng. in BC and/or Alberta". A P.Eng. would likely not be held by the named Senior, or Intermediate Professional for either Site Survey and Layout, or Hazardous Material Abatement. In both cases, work under these categories would be completed by technologists. Will it be acceptable for the proposed individuals (Senior Professional and Intermediate Professional) in these two project categories to not hold P.Eng. designations.
- A42. Professional Designations specific to each Project Category will not be set. See A39 from Amendment 4 for Discipline-specific professional requirements. Also note that Technologists and Sr. Technologists are to be included in the hourly rate table in Annex 'B'; no resumes are required for these staff
- **Q43.** Would PCA forgo the requirement for Intermediate Personnel to have a P.Eng./Architectural License and accept technologists with the required relevant experience? If PCA will not consider removing the professional engineering requirement for intermediate personnel, will PCA remove the requirement for proponents to provide Project Team Names on the Detailed Project Descriptions?
- A43. All intermediate personnel must have appropriate designations as indicated in A39 from Amendment 4. The proponents must also provide project team names on the respective detailed project descriptions.

ALL OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS REMAIN UNCHANGED.
