This amendment is raised to:

- A. Answer questions from bidders
- B. Make changes to the tender documents

Questions and Answers

Addendum No. 6 states that only one Senior and one Intermediate resume is required per Individual Discipline. Is this both the minimum and maximum number of resumes that will be evaluated per Individual Discipline? If so, this would be challenging to demonstrate in one or two individuals. For example, a structural engineer who does both buildings and bridges/culverts or, an electrical engineer who does both EV charging stations and traffic control signals or network systems.

A47. PCA is asking for:

- Senior personnel x 1 per Individual Discipline
- Intermediate personnel minimum 1 and a maximum equal to how many project categories are applicable in the Individual Discipline. For example: Civil Engineering, there can be a max of 5 Intermediate personnels.

The Senior personnel must have general experience in the discipline. The intermediate personnel experience must cover the specific project categories within the discipline. Note that intermediate(s) can handle more then one project category.

- Q48. Amendment No. 1 Q&A 20 indicated that 2 (or 3) resumes for Sr/Int Personnel was permissible. Since Q&A 20 was not rescinded, please confirm the minimum and maximum number of resumes that will be evaluated per Individual Discipline.
- A48. See above question 47
- Q49. The Page Counts Limit Table in Addendum No. 6 shows a 4-page limit for PART A: Management and Corporate Evaluation, but Addendum No. 4 increased the page limit from 4 to 8 pages for this section. Please confirm the page limit for this section is still 8 pages.
- A49. Correct, this was administratively missed on amend 6. Amendment 4 where the page limit of Part A Management and Corporate Evaluation has a page limit of 8 still applies.
- **Q50**. Amendment 6 changed the requirement for resumes from 2 per category to 2 per discipline; however, the required response tables in the Part B Technical Evaluation section of the RFSO are still asking us to name a senior individual for each category, against which they will be scored. Will these tables be altered to reflect the updated requirements, as in many cases, 1 individual may not be able to demonstrate expertise in every single category within a discipline?
- A50. In the tables in Part B Technical Evaluation, the column for named "Name of Senior Professional Personnel" will be removed. However, please clearly identify who is the Senior and Intermediate(s) for the project categories within each Individual discipline.
