1.1 THIS SOLICITATION AMENDMENT IS RAISED TO:

A. Update the language requirements in Section 4.

1.2 THIS SOLICITATION IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

A. DELETE Section 4 Business Considerations in its entirety and REPLACE with the following:

4- Business Considerations

- EDDHT screening is one of four approved methods of screening within TC's Air Cargo Security (ACS)
 Program. Both air carriers and Regulated Agents determine which screening method(s) best align with their
 business model. A Regulated Agent is an entity that is approved in the ACS Program to screen cargo on
 behalf of others to make it secure and subsequently stores and/or transports the secure cargo. EDDHT
 screening is currently only approved for cargo destined on all-cargo international and cross-border (U.S.)
 flights from Canada.
 - EDDHTs are regulated by TC. The dog teams work for unregulated canine companies that are located across the country and have contracts with Regulated Agents and air carriers. There are currently between 75-100 active EDDHTs.
 - With the current number of active EDDHTs in the program, it may initially be a part-time business opportunity for third-party certifier(s) and as the EDDHT program expands, it may become a fulltime business opportunity.
- The organizations or individuals will require a controlled physical space to conduct the certifications, in addition to various physical and infrastructure requirements to perform testing. Additional components, such as cargo commodities and logistics supplies, will also be required. The location or physical property to conduct certifications is at the discretion of the organization/individual. For example, they can leverage their own site or location, or they could leverage locations through establishing working relationships with industry stakeholders, (i.e., Regulated Agents, air carriers and EDDHT companies). The business logistics may also require coordination with government agencies, law enforcement organizations, and private sector entities, such as airport authorities.
- The organizations or individuals will be required to collaborate with EDDHT companies or other service
 providers to have access and/or store bulk explosives, required to conduct the testing, per the TC
 certification standards.
- The handling and storage of real explosives requires training and licensing in accordance with Natural Resources Canada Explosive Regulations and TC Transportation Dangerous Goods Regulations. Certain provinces have additional safety and certification requirements. It is the responsibility of organizations or individuals to perform due diligence and adhere to applicable laws and regulations.
- The organizations or individuals must be able to communicate during a certification event in either official language of Canada upon request from an applicant or designated EDDHT.
- Conflict of Interest:
 - Interested organizations or individuals will be prohibited from any business or familial association with any TC certified EDDHTs or the canine companies they work for that are seeking certification.
- Costs:
 - The Government of Canada will not provide any business grants to organizations or individuals who are interested in becoming third-party certifiers.
 - All costs incurred to attend training to become a third-party certifier will be covered by the organization or individuals.

- Third-party certifiers will set their own rates of pay for all certification tests. TC may require a breakdown of the cost structure at the application stage of the program.
- Other administrative considerations:
 - o Business implementation costs
 - Salary and expenditures
 - Training
 - Travel to attend certification event either locally or at locations across Canada such as: Montreal, Toronto, Vancouver and Calgary, etc.
 - Communications and internet fee
 - o Video recording equipment
 - o Insurance

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN THE SAME.
